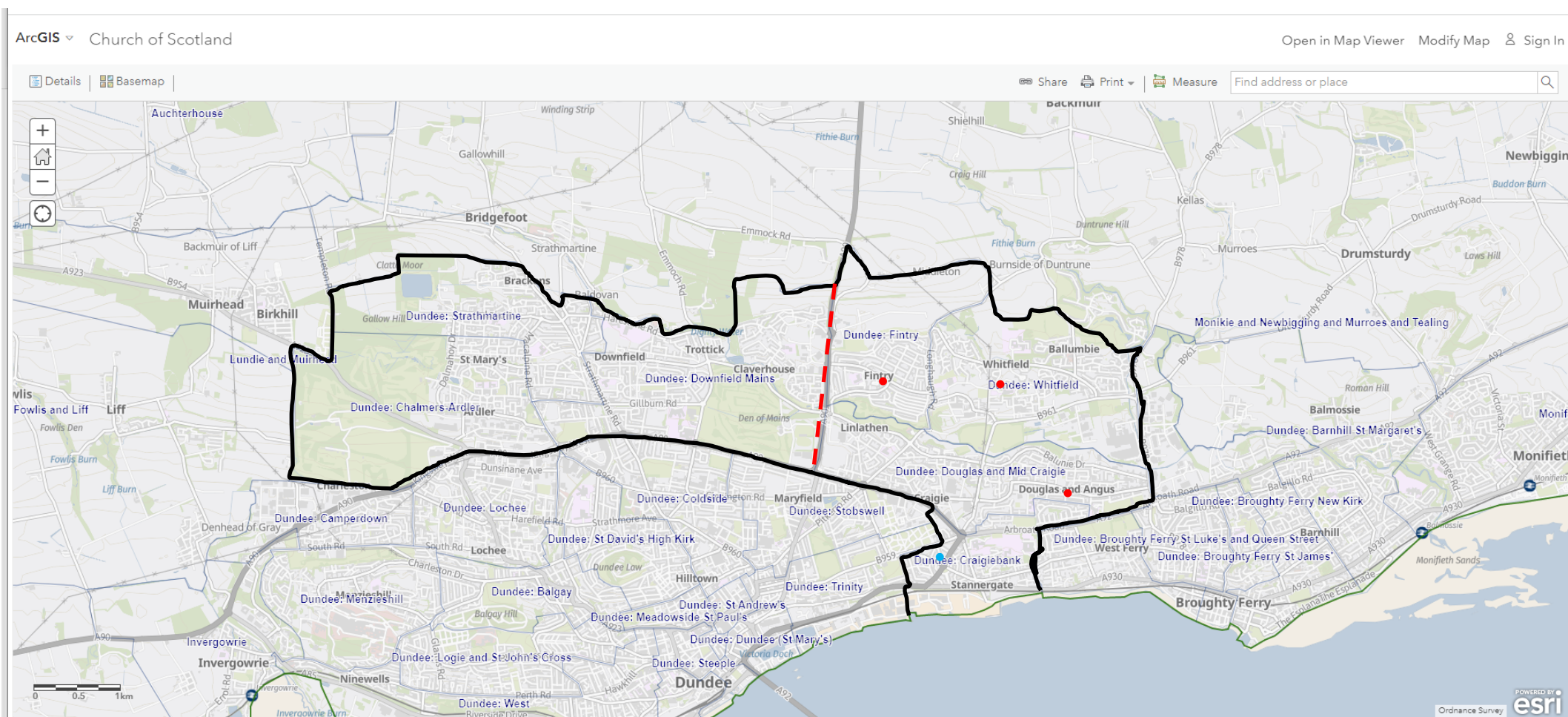

Dundee: Northeast Church of Scotland - area to the east of the dotted red line

The current Presbytery Mission Plan envisages the three charges in the North of Dundee moving towards a formal Parish Grouping.



Dundee: Northeast Church of Scotland was formed by the union of Craigiebank, Douglas & Mid Craigie, Fintry and Whitfield Parish Churches on 1st January 2024.

The Craigiebank housing estate was planned in 1918 as a garden suburb of the city. At the centre of the estate was to be a group of community buildings, including a church, a college, shops and sports facilities. However, only Craigiebank Parish Church was built. It was opened in September 1938. The church and halls were demolished in 2023 owing to structural issues.

Douglas, Fintry, Mid Craigie and Whitfield are all post war housing developments built in the 50s and 60s at a time when new housing estates were being built to the north of Dundee
